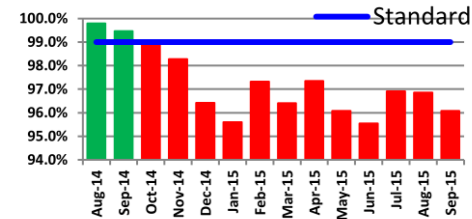

September performance is 96.08%

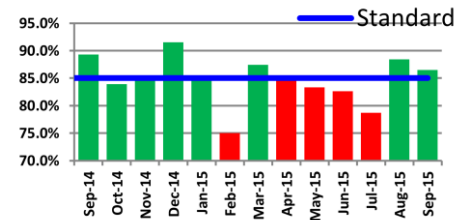


The target continues to perform below the operational standard.

**Cancer 62  
Day Standard  
(D. Gale)**

All patients need to receive first treatment for cancer within 62 days of urgent referral. The Monitor threshold is 85%.

September performance is 86.5%

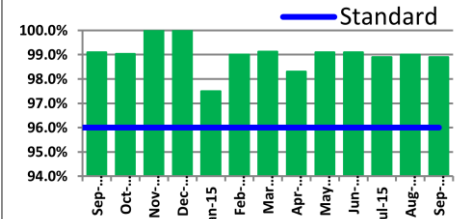


Performance continues to be in excess of the Monitor standard.

**Cancer 31  
Day Standard  
(D. Gale)**

All patients to receive first treatment for cancer within 31 days of decision to treat. The Monitor threshold is 96%.

September performance is 98.9%

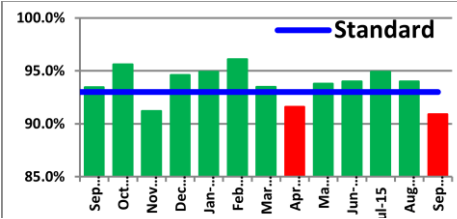


The target continues to be delivered above the Monitor threshold.

**Cancer 2 Week  
Wait  
Standard  
(D. Gale)**

All patients need to receive first appointment for cancer within 14 days of urgent referral. The Monitor threshold is 93%.

June performance is 90.9%
