Executive Summary

The annual self-certification provides assurance that NHS providers are compliant with the conditions of their NHS provider licence.

Compliance with the licence is routinely monitored through the NHS Oversight Framework however, on an annual basis, the licence requires providers to self-certify they have:

- a) Effective systems to ensure compliance with the conditions of the NHS provider licence, NHS legislation and the duty to have regard to the NHS Constitution (Condition G6) and a reasonable expectation that required resources will be available to deliver the designated services for the 12 months from the date of the statement (Condition CoS7) by 31st May 2024, and
- b) Complied with the required governance arrangements (condition FT4) by 30th June 2024.

The Trust is required to publish its self-certification on its website by the dates noted above and retain copies for record keeping purposes, noting there is no longer a requirement to submit them to NHSE.
