2. Our community response to Covid

- We are the lead provider in the Mid Nottinghamshire Integrated Care Partnership
- 15 health, care and voluntary organisations working with citizens to create happier, healthier communities
- Shared goal to reduce differences in healthy life expectancy by three years
- Formed a provider collaborative with Nottinghamshire Healthcare NHS FT





Our Example - The first 24/7 vaccine centre in the NHS

‘I felt so much more comfortable attending in the early hours when less people were in the hub’

3. Most improved NHS Trust over the last five years - Culture

- Real change does not happen overnight
- We look after the people who look after the people
- In 2015 Sherwood was 129/142 in NHS staff survey and in 2019 we were 16/142. Improved by 113 places - most in the NHS
- Only eight trusts have improved every year between 2015 and 2019
- And 2020 is even better...



- 2015 Sherwood Forest Hospitals NHS FT rated Inadequate and in Special Measures
- 2020 King's Mill Hospital (where 90% of all our services are based) is the only NHS hospital to move from Inadequate and Special Measures to Outstanding – over three CQC visits

More than a DGH...


- We have developed a replicable way to improve, with people at the heart of our thinking
