Testing for sexually transmitted infections

HIV

If the young person is over 16 and living in Nottinghamshire, and concerned regarding the need for HIV screening, they can order a free postal HIV test at: www.freetesting.hiv

Chlamydia

If the young person would like access to a free postal Chlamydia test, this can be ordered at: www.freetest.me

Tests are posted out in an unmarked white plastic bag.
