Executive Summary

The aim of the COVID-19 vaccination programme is to protect those who are most at risk of serious illness or death should they develop COVID-19, and reduce transmission of the infection, thereby contributing to the protection of vulnerable individuals who may have a suboptimal response to their own immunisation.

The supportive slides provide an overview of the contributions to date in regarding how the Trust and supported and complemented towards and citizens receiving the COVID-19 vaccine across Nottinghamshire.

The details of the vaccinations issued to date are summarised in the attached slides. The Summary highlights to date are:

- Total number of vaccinations issues in the Hospital Hub since 8th December 2020 are 79,624
- Total number of all colleagues (excluding our bank force) vaccinated 4,808 (89%) and number outstanding is 590



- Number of BME colleagues vaccinated stands at 562 (84%) and number outstanding 105
- Number of colleagues onboarded to support the vaccination programme across 9 different site locations is 5,005

Recommendation

The Trust Board is asked to take assurance from the report and to note the significant contributions made by colleagues at Sherwood to enable the successful delivery of vaccinations to the citizens of Nottinghamshire and colleagues working at Sherwood.
