| <p>The aim of the COVID-19 vaccination programme is to protect those who are most at risk of serious illness or death should they develop COVID-19, and reduce transmission of the infection, thereby contributing to the protection of vulnerable individuals who may have a suboptimal response to their own immunisation.</p> <p>The s slides provide an overview of the contributions to date in regarding how the Trust has supported colleagues and citizens receiving the COVID-19 vaccine across Nottinghamshire.</p> <p>The details of the vaccinations issued to date are summarised in the attached slides. The Summary highlights to date are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Total number of vaccinations issued in the Hospital Hub as at 20<sup>th</sup> May 2021 stands at 96,679</li> <li>• Total number of all colleagues (excluding our bank force) vaccinated 4867 (90%) and number outstanding is 531</li> </ul> |  |   |  |                                |

- Number of BME colleagues vaccinated stands at 574 (86%) and number outstanding 93
- Number of colleagues over 60 vaccinated stands at 401 (97%) and number outstanding 11
- Number of colleagues vaccinated that have historically shielded stands at 50 (89%) and number outstanding 6
