## **Executive Summary**

Submission of the SFHT Quality accounts this year was directly to NHSE/I on 30th June 2021. This is a variation as a result of Covid-19. Previous practice required submission to the DH Parliamentary office.

During the Covid-19 pandemic 2020/21, NHSE/I and the Department of Health directed providers to follow an alternative mandate in the completion of their Quality Accounts. This included the omission of external auditors. Data validation has therefore been gained via internal processes including review by quality committee.

Review by Healthwatch, Health Scrutiny Committee and CCG has been received virtually during the pandemic to gain and validate assurance.
