Escalated Risks and Issues	Accomplishments
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Phase 3 of the National COVID Vaccination Programme commenced on 17<sup>th</sup> September for eligible HSCW, Care Home staff and over 50's, offering Pfizer vaccine unless AZ is clinically required.</li> <li>AZ supply – limited nationally therefore AZ vaccines will be consolidated to avoid wastage.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>KMH Hub hours reverted back to 8am-8pm, 7 days per week</li> <li>Appointments initially available for eligible HSCW's on Swift Queue booking systems – HSCW's are now able to book on the National Booking Service (NBS) which includes a self declaration. ID required upon arrival at KMH Hub.</li> <li>Vaccinated 3,000+ Boosters doses to HSCW's and 1,600+ Over 50's</li> <li>Dose 3 vaccines available for eligible immunosuppressed patients – this dose is available 8 weeks after 2<sup>nd</sup> dose.</li> <li>Eligible Clinically Vulnerable 12-15 year olds taking vaccine at KMH Hub.</li> <li>Booster vaccines recorded on National Immunisations Management System – unable yet to report this data nationally.</li> </ul>

National/Regional Programme Status	Next Steps
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Phase 3 of Programme commenced nationally 20<sup>th</sup> September 2021.</li> <li>Focused communications to encourage 1st dose vaccination in Cohort 12 (18-29 year olds) and pregnant ladies.</li> <li>National Immunisation Management System currently unable to report Booster update, local data confirms:</li> <li>Boosters :               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>HSCWs – 3,120</li> <li>Over 50's – 1, 621</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Migrate all bookings to NBS including staff. Appointments booked on Swift Queue do not require any action . Internal comms to be circulated w/c 27 September 2021.</li> <li>Regional Programme exploring national communication relating to Phase 3 – currently unclear national comms plan.</li> <li>Pop up vaccination clinic planned to commence in Maternity from 4 October 2021 to encourage take up by pregnant women.</li> <li>Decommissioning of local vaccination sites in September include: Ashfield, Newark, Gamston. Forest Rec relocating in September to allow site improvements.</li> </ul>

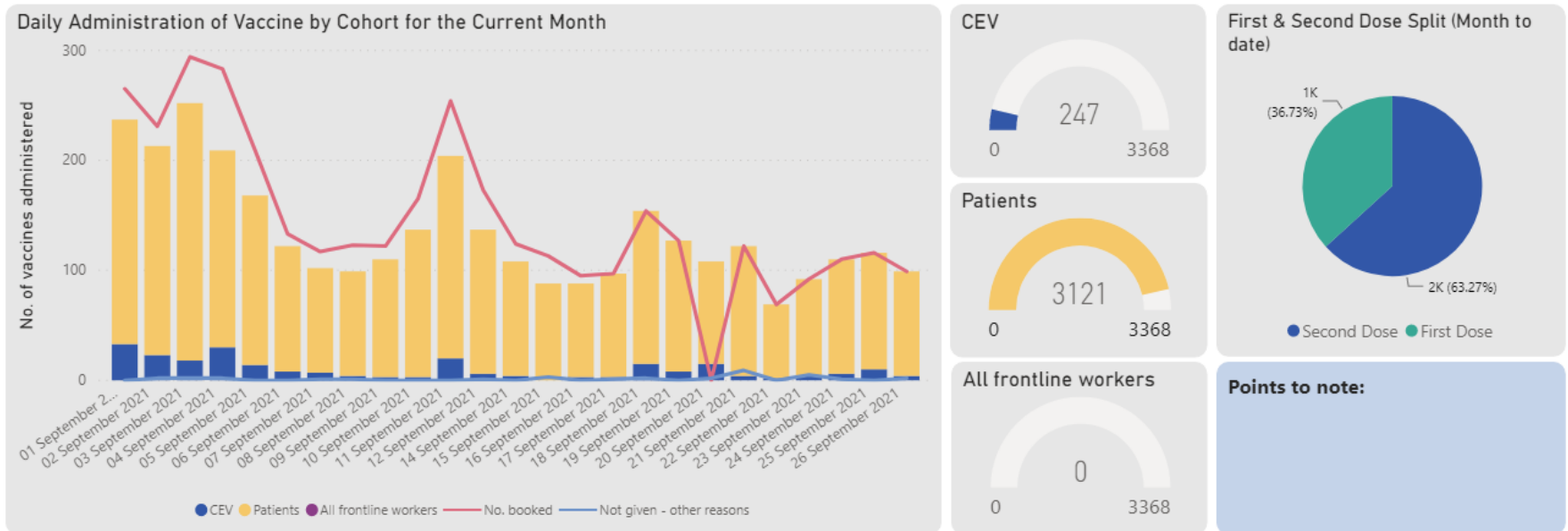
