Escalated Risks and Issues

- Phase 3 of the National COVID Vaccination Programme commenced on 17th September for eligible HSCW, Care Home staff and over 50's, offering Pfizer vaccine unless AZ is clinically required.
- AZ supply limited nationally therefore AZ vaccines will be consolidated to avoid wastage.

Accomplishments

- KMH Hub hours reverted back to 8am-8pm, 7 days per week
- Appointments initially available for eligible HSCW's on Swift Queue booking systems – HCSW's are now able to book on the National Booking Service (NBS) which includes a self declaration. ID required upon arrival at KMH Hub.
- Vaccinated 3,000+ Boosters doses to HSCW's and 1,600+ Over 50's
- Dose 3 vaccines available for eligible immunosuppressed patients this dose is available 8 weeks after 2nd dose.
- Eligible Clinically Vulnerable 12-15 year olds taking vaccine at KMH Hub.
- Booster vaccines recorded on National Immunisations Management System unable yet to report this data nationally.

National/Regional Programme Status

- Phase 3 of Programme commenced nationally 20th September 2021.
- Focused communications to encourage 1st dose vaccination in Cohort 12 (18-29 year olds) and pregnant ladies.
- National Immunisation Management System currently unable to report Booster update, local data confirms:
- Boosters :

HSCWs – 3,120 Over 50's – 1, 621

Next Steps

- Migrate all bookings to NBS including staff. Appointments booked on Swift Queue do not require any action. Internal comms to be circulated w/c 27 September 2021.
- Regional Programme exploring national communication relating to Phase 3 currently unclear national comms plan.
- Pop up vaccination clinic planned to commence in Maternity from 4
 October 2021 to encourage take up by pregnant women.
- Decommissioning of local vaccination sites in September include: Ashfield, Newark, Gamston. Forest Rec relocating in September to allow site improvements.




Performance to date (8th Dec - 26th September)




