### **Executive Summary**

#### <u>Overview</u>

As the Trust Board of Directors will recall, a paper was presented at the Board Meeting on 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2021, providing a summary of the SFH H2 priorities and their alignment to the 5 overarching Strategic Objectives as outlined in the 5-year strategy: *Healthier Communities*, *Outstanding Care*. The paper was endorsed by the Board, including a request that quarterly updates be provided.
