Mid-Nottinghamshire PBP Forum meeting – 19th May 2022

Executive Summary

The Place Based Partnership Forum (formerly known as Integrated Care Partnership Board) identified 5 PBP Objectives and 10 breakthrough objectives for 2020/2021. These provide the PBP Forum with a number of actions that would be undertaken during 2021/22 in support of delivery of the strategic objectives which provide the framework and themes in support of the overarching long term PBP vision.
