


Discharge Lounge

Information for patients



Welcome to the Discharge Lounge

You will be cared for by qualified nurses and healthcare support workers, who are here to make you feel comfortable and cared for while you await your discharge out of hospital.

Staff in the lounge work closely with ward staff, care providers, pharmacy and transport to enable you to have a safe, speedy and smooth discharge.

There can be occasions where you may have to wait a little longer for your medications or transport, but staff will keep you regularly updated. Staff are also happy to answer any questions you may have.

Facilities

The lounge currently has 4 cubicle spaces and 13 chair spaces.

While in the lounge you will be offered a choice of hot and cold drinks, which you can request at any time.

At meal times you will be offered soup and sandwiches in addition to hot or cold drinks. Special requests can be catered for where required.

Toilet facilities are available and assistance is on hand when required.

Any medications you need to take will still be given to you while you are in the lounge.

If you become unwell at any point your ward doctor will be contacted and asked to review you. The lounge has facilities to cope with medical emergencies.

Helping us

By using the lounge, your ward bed can be given to another patient who urgently requires an inpatient admission.

Transferring patients (who are well enough to go home) to the lounge helps us to reduce waiting times and improves the speed and quality of care we are able to deliver.

Opening times and location

The lounge is located on ward 35, which is on level 3. Opening times are 7am until 9pm, Monday to Friday. At weekends the lounge is usually closed, but we do open when required.

We can at times move location of the discharge lounge – this will be communicated to you by either the ward staff or the discharge lounge staff.
