Over this year I introduced a further arrangement to speak with Chairs' of committees individually after each meeting so that I could bring together the various issues and determine whether there are any themes or issues that have come from the committees that need to be addressed by the board. As a result of that feedback and discussions, we are reviewing the wider scope of the committees and membership to decide how these reflect our future implementation of our strategy. I am conscious that some committees have had significant workload and this is under review to see how we might redistribute to ensure that appropriate focus is given to each agenda item.

In the coming year NEDs will contribute and help shape our strategic plan and how we will meet the challenges facing the NHS. We will ensure that our role as an anchor organisation is at the heart of our partnership work.

I look forward to continuing to work with our NEDs over the next year. Given the expected change in NEDs over the next 18 months, we are giving appropriate focus to succession planning.
