The document was reviewed in light of the focus on fire safety after the Grenfell Tower disaster, and it was found that all the content was till relevant and no amendments were required. In the meantime, officers have reviewed the latest Health Technical Memoranda (HTM) and received specific advice from the Authorised Engineer (externally appointed expert advisor) regarding the content of an ideal Fire Policy. Based upon this advice, officers have finalised a revised Fire Policy and re-defined the previous policy as an Operational Procedure that sits alongside the policy. These revised documents will be signed off via internal governance during December 2017. Whilst executive responsibilities are clear, the guidance recommends that a Non-Executive Director be designated as the link for fire compliance matters, and this has not been the case at SFH since the departure of a previous SID. The Board is therefore requested to consider the nomination of a NED to this role.	e is e
