Executive Summary					
The Trust Board is responsible for setting appropriate objectives and accepts its legal duties to ensure compliance with its statutory responsibilities under the Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Orders 2005 and discharges its duties in providing safe and secure premises.					
The annual report is presented to provide the Trust Board with assurance that the premises are compliant with the fire safety requirements specified within fire safety legislation and the guidance documents issued under the Firecode suite of documents published by the NHS.					
Sherwood Forest Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust is required to demonstrate to the local fire authority that trust premises are compliant with the requirements of fire safety legislation and other guidance and the premises deliver a safe and secure environment in which to provide services.					
The annual report presents an overview of the strategy developed to deliver the major work streams in managing fire safety throughout the organisation. Assurances have been received from Skanska Facility Services to evidence that testing, maintenance and rectification of outstanding issues are being managed effectively.					
The Trust Board will be aware of the tragic events of the Grenfell Towers fire in London and the work the trust was required to undertake in relation to providing assurance that any structural					

materials including cladding were suitably assessed and confirmation given be the Fire Service Inspectorate as to the trusts compliances. This was the subject of a separate paper presented to the Risk Board Committee in July 2017 under Civil Contingencies Assurance and was not within the annual report period.
