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Executive Summary

Introduction:

This paper provides the Quality Committee with an update on the progress of the Quality Improvement Plan (QIP).

The QIP combines the Trust's existing Quality Improvement Plan with actions to address matters highlighted by Health Education East Midlands (HEEM), and the requirements of the Care Quality Commission. The QIP also encapsulates the action being taken to address the CQCs' enforcement actions.

There are currently 288 actions over 10 Workstreams. Good progress continues to be made to deliver the plan. Following confirm and challenge meetings held during April 2016, there are **89 (31%) actions embedded** (55 are subject to verification by the Care Quality Commission); **187 (65%) actions are completed or remain on track to be completed as planned**; and **12 (4%) actions behind plan**.

All ongoing actions have been reviewed in detail. This paper summarises the position in each workstream, and recommends 18 actions are approved for marking as embedded.
