## **Detail:**

This action is part of the wider objective to increase the number of patients going through ambulatory care pathways.

The team have used the 'There's No Place Like Home' initiative to increase the number of patients that have gone through CDU and have seen a reduction in the number of patients admitted with a 0 day LoS and between March 15 and Feb 16 there has been a two hour reduction in the average LoS on EAU.

The team in EAU have made other changes outside of TNPLH and continue to work to increase the number of patients who go on an ambulatory care pathway.

## Changes include:

- Referrals to CDU have increased through TNPLH.
- DMR referrals going directly to CDU.
- Cardiac pathway has been redesigned so patients can go straight to CDU instead of waiting in ED. This started on 28<sup>th</sup> April 2016
- The pathways for a number of conditions have been reviewed and been implemented and include a nurse led discharge process.
- Hot clinic slots have been created to enable more patients to go on an ambulatory care pathway.
