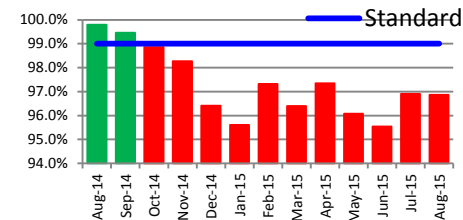

Diagnostic 6 week Standard (GMs)

All diagnostic tests need to be carried out within 6 weeks of the request for the test being made. The operational target is 99% or over within 6 weeks.

August performance is 96.86%

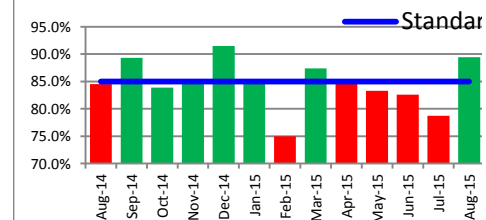


The target continues to perform below the standard whilst diagnostic backlogs are cleared. Recovery plans show performance is also behind the trajectories set. In month performance has suffered from mobile MRI availability which has been rectified in September.

Cancer 62 Day Standard (D. Gale)

All patients need to receive first treatment for cancer within 62 days of urgent referral. The Monitor threshold is 85%.

August performance is 89.4%

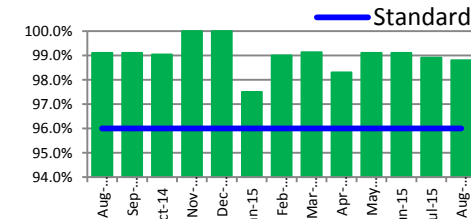


Performance in August is above the Monitor standard. An improvement programme is in place led by Cancer Programme Director.

Cancer 31 Day Standard (D. Gale)

All patients to receive first treatment for cancer within 31 days of decision to treat. The Monitor threshold is 96%.

August performance is 98.8%

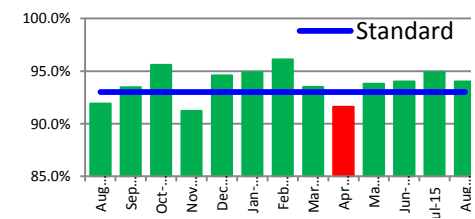


The target continues to be delivered above the Monitor threshold.

Cancer 2 Week Wait Standard (D. Gale)

All patients need to receive first appointment for cancer within 14 days of urgent referral. The Monitor threshold is 93%.

August performance is 94%.



Delivery of threshold has been maintained (for the fourth consecutive month) in August.
