The Annual Organisational Audit and the monitoring processes within it are designed to support all responsible officers in fulfilling their statutory duty, providing a means by which they can demonstrate the effectiveness of the systems they oversee.

The aims of the annual organisational audit exercise are to:

- gain an understanding of the progress that organisations have made during 2017/18;
- provide a tool that helps responsible officers assure themselves and their board that the
 systems underpinning the recommendations they make to the General Medical Council
 (GMC) on doctors' fitness to practise, the arrangements for medical appraisal and
 responding to concerns are in place, provide a mechanism for assuring NHS England and
 the GMC that systems for evaluating doctors' fitness to practice are in place, functioning,
 effective and consistent.
