Executive Summary				
<p>The SFH QI Strategy was launched in July 2018 and ongoing cascade via QI Toolbox Talks is progressing. To date, 63 staff have undertaken Bronze and 25 Silver level training on the QSIR programme; the SFH joint approach with ICS partners has been recognised nationally. SFH visited the Sheffield System partnership working in October to create working links. Three Masterclasses with external speakers were hosted in 2018. A QI Showcase was held in October as part of the Clinical Leadership Programme and the next one is scheduled for Q1 2019. SFH delivered 2 talks and 4 posters at the East Midlands QI Network Event in October. We have engaged with a Regional Programme called ORDA to develop a Knowledge Management system. The "My Bright Idea" website has been established at SFH with the intention for this to become the QI Platform across the ICS. Patient Safety Culture surveys have been conducted in ED and Maternity with ongoing work in Theatres. Internally QI Pow Wows begin in February and support has been given to process mapping Complaints, Cancer pathways, Day Case Hip surgery pilot and Fractured Neck of Femur pathways. QI training and development has been given to Chief Nurse Fellows and Clinical Leadership development. This has been achieved despite considerable resource constraints.</p>
