Executive Summary

The Allied Health Professional (AHP) strategy for SFH has been developed over a number of months through a series of engagement sessions, workshops, interactions and comments from the full range of AHP colleagues. It has been aligned to the 2018 Nursing and Midwifery Strategy and the more recent Trust Strategy.

We have directly consulted with over 200 staff which equate to 50% of our AHP workforce. The objectives have been developed from the direct contributions made by everyone who shared their thoughts and ambitions for the future of our patients and AHPs at Sherwood Forest Hospital.

A number of objectives across this strategy have been identified which as an AHP group, we commit to convert into achievable actions. Where these are already in place we will celebrate and promote these and look to further enhance their value. There will be new opportunities to improve our services which we pledge to translate into tangible benefits and actions. We will provide regular forums to meet with each other and with the support of our other colleagues will deliver on the expectations expressed here.
