Executive Summary

The attached reports provide an update on the Memorandum of Understanding between the ICS and NHS England and Improvement for 2019/20.

This year, the MOU has been populated using a standard template and sets out the national expectations of ICSs, the freedoms and flexibilities that these systems will gain in return, and how the national leadership bodies will work to support system leaders and their teams. The items that the ICS were asked to include were:

- The local priorities and deliverables agreed by the ICS Board on 13 June.
- The financial framework, agreed by the ICS Board on 12 July 2019

The Independent Chair of the ICS received a final copy from the region on 30 July. In order to ensure that transformation funding was authorised, it was required to sign the MOU by 31 July. An analysis of the content demonstrated that it is essentially the same as the previously circulated draft MOU and the agreed priorities and funding. On this basis the MOU was signed and returned by the Independent Chair.

The ICS will be held accountable for progress against this framework over the coming months as the system evolves.

Alongside this MOU, system leaders were asked to self-assess against the national ICS Maturity Matrix.

Board are asked to note the requirements of the ICS MOU for 2019/20 and note the Maturity Matrix assessment.
