Subject to paragraph 8.6.3, the Chairman and the other Non-Executive Directors are to be appointed for a period of office in accordance with the terms and conditions of office (including as to remunerations and allowances, which shall be published in the Annual Report) decided by the Council of Governors in general meeting. Non-Executive Directors: 8.6.3.1 shall be appointed for a period of up to 3 years; are, subject to paragraphs 8.6.3.3 and 8.6.3.4 eligible for re-election at 8.6.3.2 the end of the period referred to in paragraph 8.6.3.1; 8.6.3.3 shall not, except in exceptional circumstances, hold office for a period in excess of 6 years; and 8.6.3.4 where appointed for more than 6 years shall, at the discretion of the Council of Governors, be so appointed either on the basis of: a) annual re-appointment; or b) a competitive process up to a maximum 9 years.
