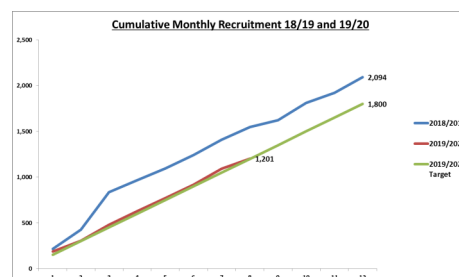

Oncology Outlook

We have recently opened 3 new Oncology Trials, see how they benefit our patients...

ICI Genetics

The study that is looking at the possible role of inherited factors that may increase a person's chances of having side-effects of particular anti-cancer therapies also known as 'Immune Checkpoint Inhibitors'

Our Research team has already recruited 50 patients who have lung and kidney cancer, with another 4 years to go!



Not all people benefit from chemotherapy with this type of breast cancer. The study tests tumour samples to identify if chemotherapy is beneficial alongside hormone therapy. Some patients may not require chemotherapy and receive truly personalised care
