## Executive Summary

The Sherwood Forest Hospitals Trust Board are asked to note the contents of the attached report, outlining the progress made by the Midlands and East 2 (ME2) Pathology Network over the last year.

The report outlines a number of workstreams, some of which have progressed, but others require a more formal structure or additional resources to progress.

The Board is asked to support the 8 steps outlined on pages 6, 7 and 8, seen as essential to progress and deliver the outputs the Network is expected to achieve. Of particular note is the requirement to prioritise Network procurement above individual Trust initiatives, unless there is a specific service or patient risk that requires immediate action.
