The Butterfly Suite

The Butterfly Suite

This purpose-built suite was designed to create an atmosphere of quiet and support. It is a safe space, creating the opportunity for families to spend as much time as they wish with their baby before being discharged home.

Enhanced by soft furnishings, pictures, plants, neutral colours, a kitchen area and a private bathroom, the Butterfly Suite allows families privacy, respect and dignity during their stay. We recognise that nothing can ease the pain of losing a loved one, however, this environment aims to prevent added distress and provide a pleasant space to create precious memories with baby.



We have two specialised 'Abi' cooling cots, which allow families to spend more time with their baby.





Who can use the Butterfly Suite?

Any families experiencing a loss who are 20 weeks' gestation or more.

Where is the Butterfly Suite?

The suite is situated at the end of the Sherwood Birthing Unit.

Visiting times

There are no set visiting times. Family and friends can visit 24 hours a day, seven days a week at the family's discretion. All we ask is that friends and family respect the ward staff and are mindful of other patients on the ward.

Parking

We advise that you park in any patient car park within the hospital. When leaving the Butterfly Suite please enquire about a free parking ticket.
