INFORMATION FOR PATIENTS

Osler test

Your doctor has requested that we perform a test to assess your levels of alertness.

What is an Osler test?

This is a simple test that tells us how sleepy you are.

You will be required to lie upright on a couch for 40 minutes and respond to a light by pressing a monitor. This will be performed four times throughout the day.

Lunch will be provided as you cannot leave the department whilst the test is carried out.

Before the test

Before attending for your Osler test, please avoid containing caffeine for four hours.

Please continue to take all your medications as normal.

Please allow eight hours for this appointment

The results

The results will go to your doctor who will explain them to you at your next clinic visit.

Please note that you will not be given the results on the day of your test.
