

Yearly update for Sherwood Forest Hospitals NHSFoundation Trust 2017 – 2018












Our hospital provides services for lots of people across Mansfield, Ashfield, Newark, Sherwood and parts of Derbyshire and Lincolnshire.

We are proud to be part of Sherwood Forest Hospitals and we are working more with other services to provide better care and support across Nottinghamshire.




There have been some challenges over the year of 2017. The team has responded to these by listening and learning so that every patient receives a good level of care.






