Sleep studies on Ward 25

Your doctor has requested that we perform an overnight recording of your breathing during your sleep.

This test is usually performed to see if you stop breathing for short periods in your sleep (this is called sleep apnoea). We may also need to assess whether you need extra oxygen overnight.

If you do not attend for this test we will not be able to pass on important medical information to your doctor, which may affect the medical treatment you receive.

Test instructions

A sleep study involves coming into the hospital for one night to have your sleep monitored.

The test is very simple and will involve connecting a small probe to your finger and three stickers to your chest. These connect to a small box attached around your middle with elasticated belt.

The sleep study will be recorded including images and sound of you while sleep.

What will I need to bring with me?

We advise you bring:

- Nightclothes
- Slippers
- Toiletries
- A towel.

You may also bring anything else you may require for an overnight stay.

What will happen when I arrive?

Ward 25 is a busy ward so please be patient with the staff, they will be with you as soon as possible.

They will show you to a side room where you will spend the night. They will explain the procedure to you and then connect the equipment.

Parents/carers

Only **one** adult can stay overnight with the child, and a camp bed will be provided. We ask that siblings **do not** attend, where possible, due to the limited space and the ward environment.

If you have any difficulties with these arrangements or your child has individual needs that may require additional support, please contact us in advance. We will do our best to accommodate individual circumstances where possible.

Please let the ward staff know your car registration number, as you are not required to pay for parking.

Results

A consultant will look at your sleep study and will write directly to you with the results. Any further tests or treatments required will be arranged as necessary.

Please note that you may not be given the results on the day of your test.
